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### DRESS CODE POLICY

All parents are reminded that **the uniform policy is strictly enforced** and Students are required to wear the **APPROVED** uniform for PYA, which includes the following:

- School uniform T-shirt/polo shirt purchased from PYA (T-shirts are only to be worn on Fridays if student has exhibited proper behavior during the week).
- Navy blue uniform pants/skirts/skort
- **Solid black shoes** with solid **black** shoestrings (**open toe shoes are prohibited**)
- **Solid navy** or **black** socks or tights
- **Only solid black, gray, navy or white** t-shirts are to be worn under the PYA shirts
- **Only solid black, gray, navy or white** long sleeve shirts are to be worn under the PYA uniform shirts during the cooler weather

Students must wear a **solid black** belt with uniform bottoms that have belt loops.

Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Sagging pants are unacceptable. Skirts cannot be shorter than the tip of the finger when the arm is held down by the sides.

**BLUE OR BLACK JEANS** (jean material ONLY) are worn on Fridays along with the student's shoe of choice (closed toed shoes ONLY), as an incentive if the student has exhibited proper behavior during the week. Parents will receive written notification if students have violated their privilege to dress down.

Outer layers of clothing (jackets, coats, sweaters, etc.) should be able to button or zip in the front the PYA uniform can be visible, therefore, hoodies are not acceptable.

Uniforms must be clean and wrinkle free. Shirts are to be neatly tucked at all times, no jewelry is allowed except watches, and girls may wear conservative earrings. As we teach character, self-confidence and pride, it is imperative that students realize the importance of (1) following rules such as dress code; (2) expressing their individuality through academic and intellectual ability versus their ability to wear name brands or attention seeking apparel; and (3) representing PYA with pride and honor.
